LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf
Please refer to notices in pro-shop for temporary local rules

Fixed Sprinkler Heads

All fixed sprinkler heads are Immovable Obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16.1. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows:

If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a bunker and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which

- a) is no nearer the hole
- b) avoids such intervention and
- c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

Abnormal Course Conditions (including Immovable Obstructions)

The following are defined as Abnormal Course Conditions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16 ie one club length no nearer the hole from the nearest point of complete relief.

- a) Staked trees and shrubs, bunker rake holders and fairway distance markers
- b). Areas marked with white lines or temporary barriers,
- c). All garden beds and washaways in bunkers,
- d). All exposed tree roots on fairways or in bunkers.

Out of Bounds-Outside and Inside Course Boundaries

Boundaries are all boundary fences, the river, and green keepers shed area defined with white pegs and the dam defined by the fence line.

NOTE

No local rule applies for OOB and a lost ball. A stroke and distance penalty is the only option.
